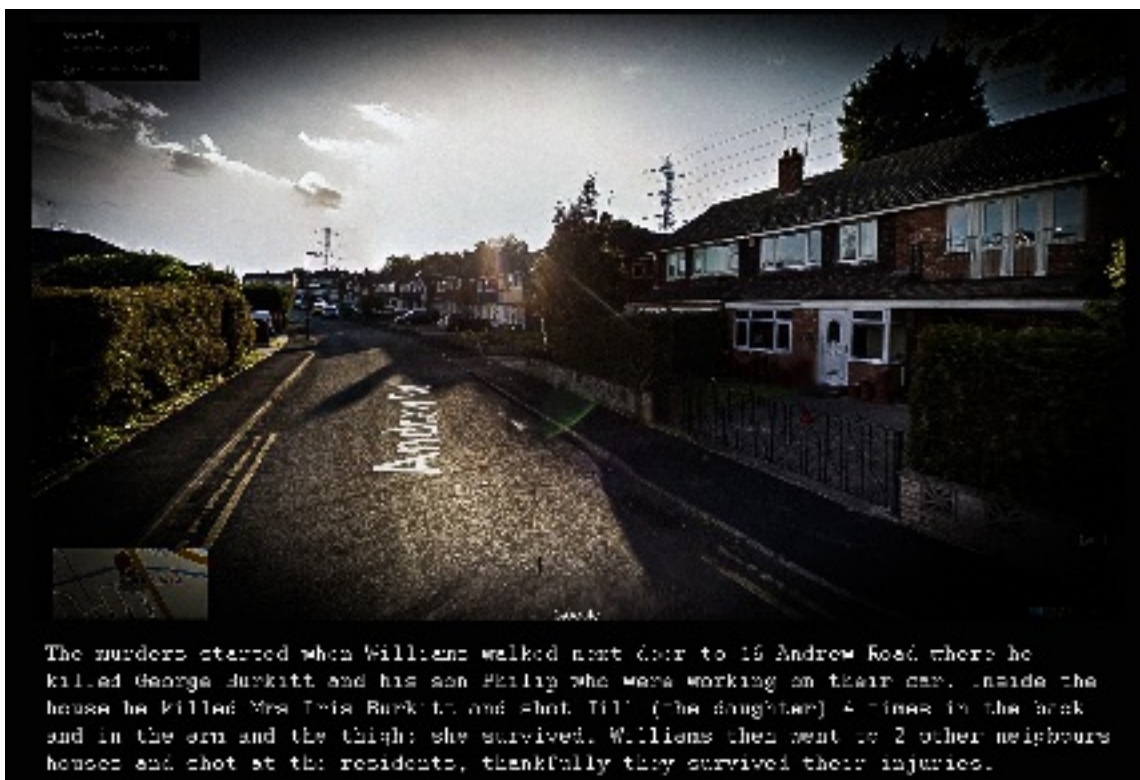


Barry Williams (1944 - 2014)
The Story of a Serial Killer



The murders started when Williams walked next door to 15 Andrew Road where he killed George Duckitt and his son Philip who were working on their car. Inside the house he killed Mrs Iris Duckitt and shot Jill (the daughter) 4 times in the back and in the arm and the thigh; she survived. Williams then went to 2 other neighbours houses and shot at the residents, thankfully they survived their injuries.



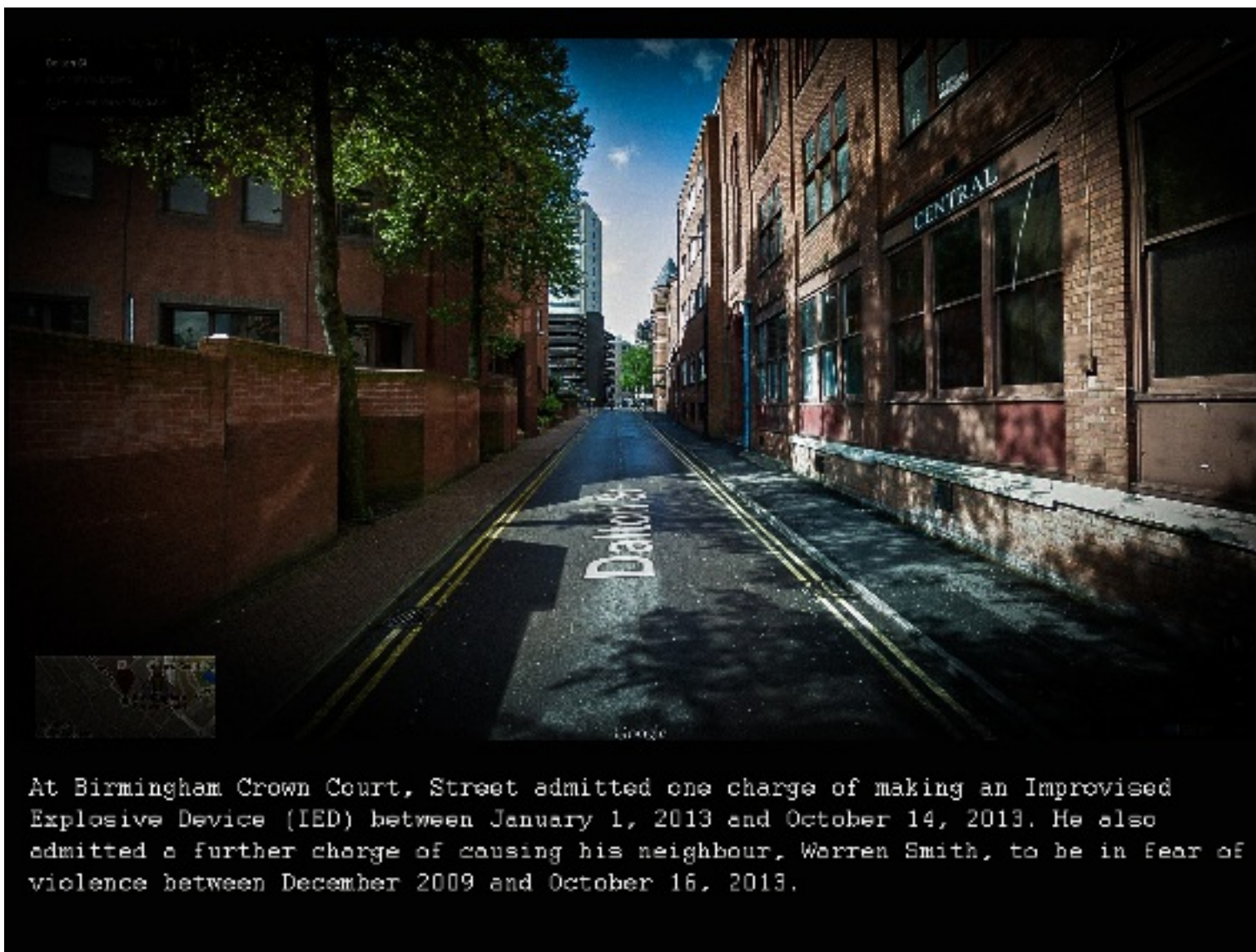














Justice William Blair stated that Street's lack of physical harm "makes no practical difference" because of the background of 1979. "Street is suffering from a mental condition and should be subject to special restrictions under the Mental Health Act. The effect of those restrictions is that the defendant may never be released". Hilliers died on the 21 December 2014 from a suspected heart attack whilst on remand at Ashworth Hospital, Huddersfield.
